Qualification Requirements

- **Must be uninsured / underinsured (with household budget info) and a Stark County resident**
- **Must be at or below 250% of Federal Poverty Guidelines:**
 - One Person Household = 29,425**
 - Two Person Household= 39,825.**
 - Three Person Household= 50,225**
 - Four Person Household= 60,625**

Must bring for an appointment

- **Income Verification for all household members**
 - *At least 2 paystubs for each member & Prior year tax return if filed**
- **Photo Identification & Verification of address if not the same as what is on the Photo ID**
- **Social Security Card**
- **Bring Prescriptions, medicine bottles, (must have current scripts or refills available.)**

WHAT TO BRING:

Income verification for all household members.

Last year's tax return, if you filed.

Driver's license or other photo ID.

Verification of address if it doesn't match photo ID.

Social Security card.

Any prescriptions, medicine bottles, current scripts, or refills.

Verification of household expenses if underinsured.

Once qualified, medications can be filled immediately if in-stock or ordered within 5 days.

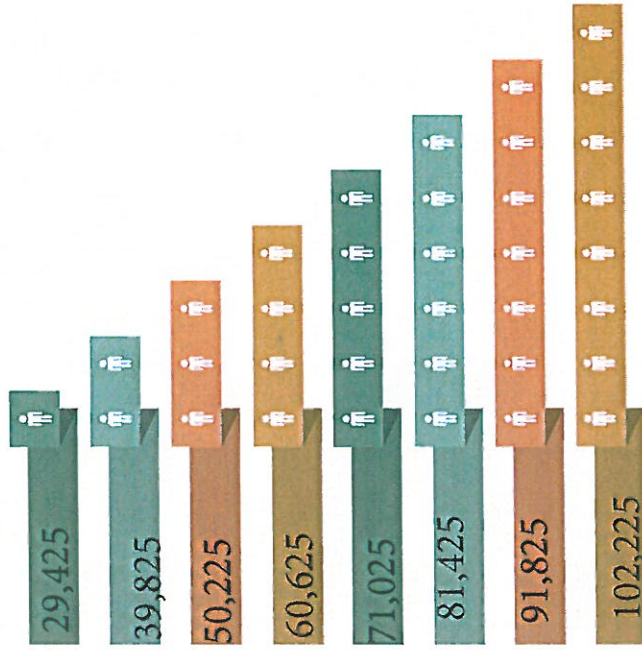
Qualification lasts one year or when circumstances change. Clients may receive their medications monthly.

What is PAN?

The Prescription Assistance Network of Stark County, inc. (PAN) provides uninsured/underinsured Stark county residents access to medication and advice through the Pan Charitable Pharmacy. Over the past 4 years, the Pan Charitable Pharmacy has filled more than 40,000 prescriptions for Stark county residents. We ask that you call ahead to make an appointment, walk-ins are welcome, but your wait will be longer and our experts won't be able to spend as much time with you. Please keep in mind that not all medications are available through this program. Specifically, no medications that appear on the government's controlled substance list are available through the Prescription Assistance Network.
