WHEREAS, upon due investigation and consideration, the Board of Trustees of Plain Township has determined that the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten (10) mill limitation in and for said Plain Township, Stark County, Ohio, for the next five years will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements for said Plain Township, Stark County, Ohio and the Plain Township Fire Department for providing and maintaining fire apparatus, mechanical resuscitators, underwater rescue and recovery equipment, or other fire equipment and appliances, buildings and sites therefor, or sources of water supply and materials therefor, for the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire-alarm communications, for the payment of firefighting companies or permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighting, emergency medical service, administrative, or communications personnel to operate the same, including the payment of any employer contributions required for such personnel under section 145.48 or 742.34 of the Revised Code, for the purchase of ambulance equipment, for the provision of ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or firefighting company, or for the payment of other related costs of Plain Township, Stark County. Ohio: and
